ORGANIZATION PROFILE

Virginia Credit Union is a not-for-profit financial cooperative owned by its members headquartered in Richmond, Virginia. It offers its members a variety of affordable banking services, including savings and checking accounts, loans, credit cards and mortgages. In addition, Virginia Credit Union provides financial education resources to members and the community.

As a cooperative, Virginia Credit Union operates solely for the benefit of its members, not outside stockholders. Earnings of the cooperative are returned to the membership through lower fees, attractive rates, helpful services and financial education. Members receive personal attention through a full-service call center, branches, shared facilities and online services. Online banking, ATM networks and debit cards provide 24-hour worldwide access.

Serving members' financial needs since 1928, Virginia Credit Union was originally chartered as State Employees' Credit Union, Inc. Today, its field of membership includes employees and retirees of Virginia's state and local governments, students at state-supported colleges and universities, employees and retirees of other approved groups, and individuals in their immediate families and households. Also among those served are individuals within the cities of Richmond, Fredericksburg, Hopewell and Petersburg, the counties of Buckingham, Cumberland, Nottoway and Prince Edward, and the Town of Farmville.
